1. Discuss and vote on berm extension in Brasher Creek

Mayor Bailey asked Bill Rush, Lake Preservation Committee Chairman, to go over the options from C & C Contracting that he had explained during the last meeting.

The following options were submitted:

Option #1 Haul it off. This could be rough on the roads since it will be over 100 loads.

Option #2 Use the silt to lengthen the Brasher Creek berm.

Option #3 Do nothing at this time.

The pros and cons of extending the berm and removing the cofferdams were discussed.

If the Town chooses to haul the silt away, James Nelms, from Lakeview Baptist Church, stated that they have a huge hole that could be filled. This would be a close location for disposal.

Ramzi Malek made the motion to not do any work on Brasher Creek at this time. Sam Pearson seconded the motion. Ramiz Malek voted yes, all others voted no. The motion denied.

Carl Randall made a motion to remove silt by truck and deposit elsewhere. Ramzi Malek seconded the motion. Carl Randall and Ramzi Malek voted yes, all others voted no. The motion denied.

Sam Pearson made the motion to remove the silt, remove cofferdams and extend the berm. Bobby Rhodes seconded the motion. Ramzi Malek and Carl Randall voted no, all others voted yes. The motion passed.

Mayor Bailey asked the Council if they would like to go look at the area and discuss additional options before adjourning. They decided to adjourn.

Carl Randall made the motion to adjourn, and Ramzi Malek seconded the motion. All were in favor.

The meeting adjourned at 3:40 pm.
